

NOTICE of EXECUTIVE SESSION

Immediately following Regular Board Meeting

Pursuant to IC 5-14-1.5-6.1:

The Board of School Trustees will meet in executive session on the topics checked as permitted under this statute.

- 1. Where authorized by federal or state statute.
- 2. For discussion of strategy with respect to:
 - A. Collective Bargaining
 - B. Initiation of litigation or pending or threatened specifically in writing.
 - C. Implementation of security systems.
 - D. Purchase or lease of real property up to the time a contract or option to purchase or lease executed.
- 3. To receive information about and interview prospective employees.
- 4. With respect to any individual over whom the governing board has jurisdiction:
 - A. To receive information concerning the individual's alleged misconduct; and
 - B. To discuss the individual's status as an employee, student, or independent contractor who is a physician or a school bus driver.
- 5. For discussion of records classified as confidential by state or federal statute.
- 6. To discuss before any placement decision an individual student's abilities past performances, behavior and needs.
- 7. To discuss the job performance evaluation of individual employees.
- 8. When considering the appointment of a public official (in this case a School Board member):
 - A. Develop a list of prospective applicants.
 - B. Consider applications.
 - C. Make one (1) initial exclusion of prospective appointees from further consideration.
- 9. To train school board members with an outside consultant about the performance of their role as public officials.

In keeping with the confidential nature of executive sessions, no member of the Board shall disclose the content of discussions that take place during such sessions. I.C. 5-14-1.5-5/6, 5-14-1.5-6.1
